HB58 law states that each school shall have a plan in place to promote positive behaviors in students.

School-hosted Family Activities

These activities will provide opportunities for students to bond at a school based activity.

- Family Movie night sponsored by the PTA
- Hero Night sponsored by the PTA

Healthy Relationships Activities

These activities will encourage students to participate in positive activities and behaviors.

- Friendship Week sponsored by the PTA: Every student receives a positive note
- Friendship Groups: Small groups of students meet with the school counselor to develop and practice friendship skills.
- Spirit Day sponsored by the PTA: Every Friday students are encouraged to wear their school shirts and/or school colors to represent being part of the school community.
- Stem and Chess Clubs: These clubs provide opportunities for everyone student (especially those who many not participate in other extracurricular activities) to be a part of a group
- **'No One Plays Alone' Friendship Benches: These benches will provide a designated place where students can go if they want someone to play with. Students will be encouraged to be aware of others during recess; if they notice anyone is alone, invite them to play.

Personal Development and Resiliency Activities

These activities will provide opportunities to increase knowledge and strengthen skills to enable students to make healthy choices throughout their lives.

- Red Ribbon Week: school-wide activity Theme Days to promote a drug free life
- Monthly classroom lessons to promote health and personal development
- Calm Boxes in each classroom: provide tools for students to use as they practice regulation their emotions
- Skills Coaches who work with our higher need students: check in daily to give encouragement and praise
- Parent meetings as needed to help assist students that are struggling
- Student Support Team meets bi-monthly: discuss students with higher needs and make plans to help them be more successful
